Happy New Year

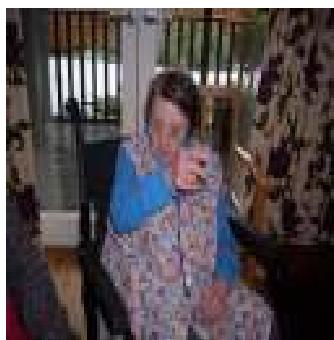
